

Dental Implant Treatment

So, what exactly is a Dental Implant?

A dental implant is an artificial replacement for a tooth root. It is usually made from titanium. Dental implants have some form of internal screw thread or post space that allows a variety of components to be fitted. Once fitted, these components provide the foundation for long-term support of crowns, bridges or dentures.



Can anyone have Dental Implants?

Dental implants are suitable for most adults with good general health. They can only be used once the jawbone has stopped growing. There is no upper age limit.

How long does the treatment take?



For routine cases, from the time of the implant placement to the time of placing the first tooth/teeth, treatment times can vary from six weeks to six months. However care must be taken with poorer bone, which can extend treatment time beyond six months. the Dentist will provide you with a written assessment summary.



What should you know before you start treatment?

In one of your appointments with the Dentist, you should be give a written summary of your treatment planning discussions, which will include an overview of the treatment's stages, how long the treatment is going to take and the fee for it.

How long it will last?



It depends on your personal attention to oral hygiene and willingness to attend appropriate maintenance reviews. This will have the most influence on how long your implant will last.

Dermal fillers can be used to fill deep lines and wrinkles and add volume to lips and cheeks. Dermal fillers usually last between 6-18 months.



If you want to achieve a smooth complexion, then Botox may be the treatment for you! Botox relaxes the muscles in the face and reduces muscle movement to correct lines and wrinkles.

Commonly treated areas are: frown lines, forehead lines and crows feet. Botox usually lasts around 3-4 months and is a minimally invasive treatment for patients who do not want to have surgery.



Bruxism


BRUXISM MEANS TEETH GRINDING. MORE ACCURATELY, BRUXISM DESCRIBES A RANGE OF RELATED BEHAVIOURS INCLUDING TEETH GRINDING, GNASHING AND CLENCHING OF THE JAW. BRUXISM IS USUALLY A SUBCONSCIOUS BEHAVIOUR THAT WE CAN EXPERIENCE DURING OUR SLEEP.



Early recognition of Bruxism can lead to improvement of your mental health and well being. If one or more of the above symptoms apply to you, do not be afraid to discuss treatment options with one of our dentists at your next checkup.




Bruxism



Mouth guards and splints are one of the treatments we use for bruxism.

Splints even out the pressure across your jaw and create a physical barrier between your upper and lower teeth to protect them from further damage. They can also reduce any grinding noises you make at night.

Mouth guards are similar to those used in sports, such as boxing or rugby. They are rubber or plastic and can be made by your dentist to fit your mouth. Mouth guards from your local pharmacist are unlikely to fit as well as custom-made ones.

Chris has always loved running, he has participated in various half marathons including the Roman Run held in Wales. The last half marathon that he took part in was in Bath.






Danielle's love for running started in 2010 when she set a challenge for herself by completing her first ever 10K. She loves going to park run with her friends and joining local competitions.

World Veteran Fencing Championships



We asked Valerie, our business administrator, to write a piece as she has an exciting event coming up...

I have been selected to fence as part of the GBR team at the World Veteran Fencing Championships in Cairo, Egypt, in October!

I came to fencing quite late in life, after years of driving my daughter to training sessions and competitions around the country. Eventually I decided I might as well have a go, and fell in love with it.

Fencing is a great way to keep fit and it can be a really social sport. I am a member of two fencing clubs, Bath Sword Club and Wessex Blades (in Warminster), attend training sessions twice a week and compete at competitions on average twice a month.

To fence as a Veteran you must be over 40, with separate age categories for some events. I have recently moved into the 60 – 69 age category (Cat 3). As you might imagine, members of British Veterans Fencing (BVF) are a very sociable group and veteran events are great fun (but also very competitive!). In May, I competed at the European Veteran Fencing Championships in Cognac, France; a huge event with over 1,800 fencers. It was very enjoyable but of course the competition was very intense; a great experience.

My result from the Europeans, together with a gold medal for my age category in the BVF National Championships, means I have now been selected for the GBR squad for the Worlds!


