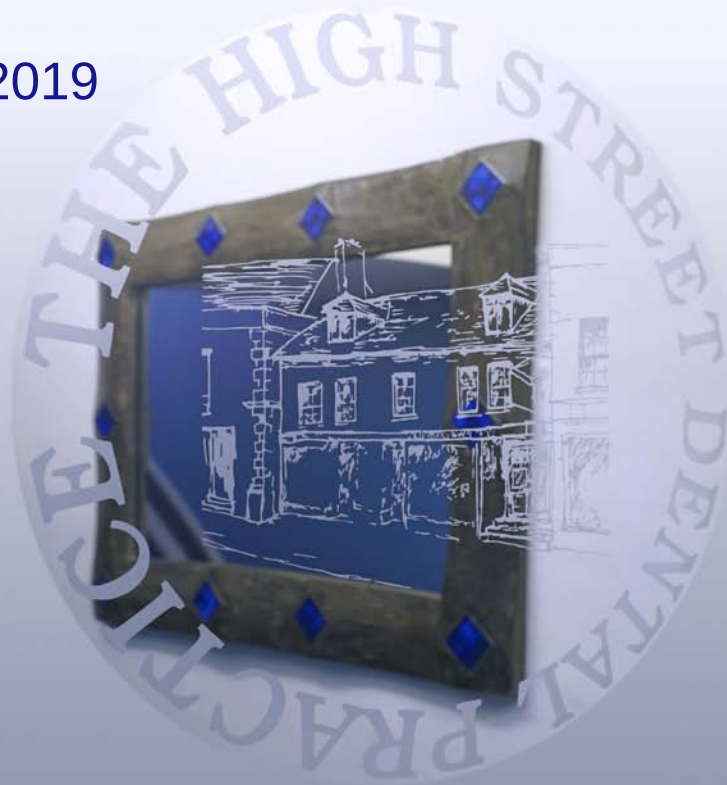

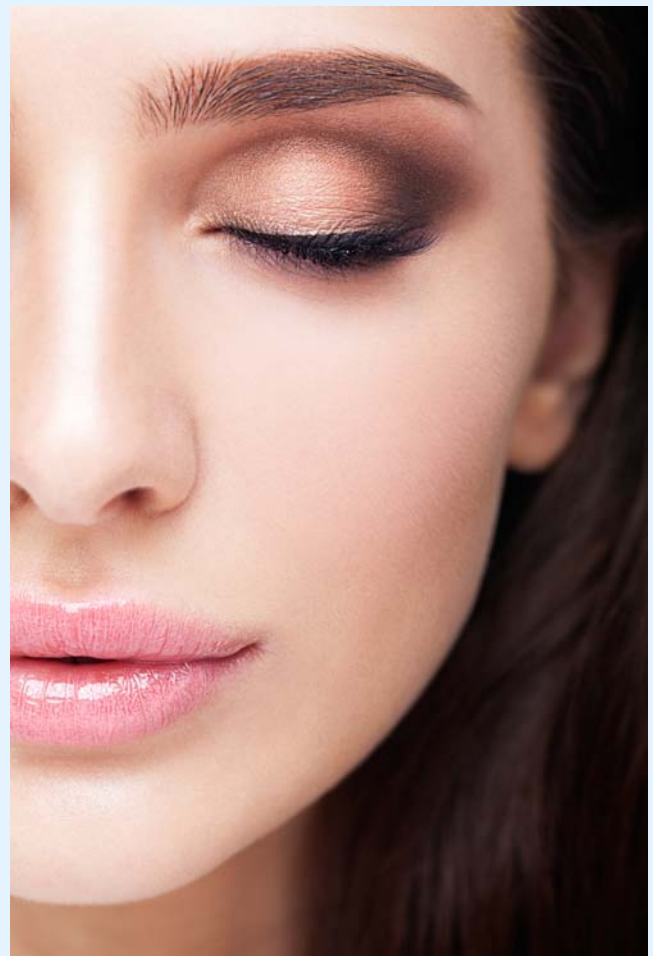
In her spare time Olivia loves walking her cocker spaniel, Sophie, and dachshund, Daphne, around the Wiltshire countryside as well as keeping chickens.

Teeth Whitening



WHAT IS TEETH WHITENING?

Teeth whitening involves bleaching your teeth to make them lighter. It can't make your teeth brilliant white, but it can lighten the existing colour by several shades.

IS THERE ANYONE WHO SHOULD NOT WHITEN THEIR TEETH?

Pregnant women, those with gum disease, worn enamel, cavities, and exposed roots should not whiten their teeth.

WHO CAN DO TEETH WHITENING?

Teeth whitening is a form of dentistry and should only be carried out by a dentist. Some beauty salons offer teeth whitening, but this is illegal if there's no dental professional present, and it may put your oral health at risk.

WHAT HAPPENS DURING TEETH WHITENING?

You'll need to make several visits to the dental surgery over a couple of months. The dentist will take an impression of your teeth to make whitening trays and tell you how to use it with a bleaching gel.

IS TEETH WHITENING PERMANENT?

Teeth whitening isn't permanent. It can last from a few months to up to 3 years – it varies from person to person.

WILL TEETH WHITENING WORK ON FALSE TEETH?

Teeth whitening doesn't work on dentures, crowns, fillings or veneers.
